



- I just completed this table runner which I purchased as a kit from "The Cloth Shop" in Vancouver.
- This Table Runner measures 18 by 69.
- Easy to make. Basically you just need to sew 24 fabrics that measure 3.5 inches by 20 inches together and then quilt it. I used pink glide thread and just did swirls.

Rosebuds – Donna F


- Donna F This a community quilt I recently completed.

- I quilted around the outside with 12 wt variegated thread, but for the center florals, I only used the 12 wt in the bobbin because it was too overpowering on the top.




Baby Panel QuiltJulie O

- Made and quilted by me




Joyce W Quilt Julie O

 Cancer quilt made from 4 inch squares. The top was going to be downright boring so put the yellow inserts to break it up. Made and quilted by me.

- I used up a lot of strips and leftover bindings for these projects.
- All the fabrics cam from my stash, including 2 and 2.5: squares that had been cut for a project that had been abandoned.
- Both flimsies were completed in February 2022 and have since been sent to Chilliwack for backing, quilting and binding and will be donated to their Community Quilts




Fidgets – Lyn G

- These were made for two people afflicted with Alzheimer's Disease.
- Apparently these are very comforting to those with the disease and those with severe autism, especially young children.
- The recommended block size is 6 to 8 inches which allows the patient to feel the materials.
- All types of fabric and notions are used as these are to sensory quilts.



Fidgets – Lyn G

- No Pattern just ideas from various posts on the Internet
- :one is 26" inches square and the other is 30 inches square.
- I thoroughly enjoyed making these although they are a little time consuming.
- I used hand-painted mug rugs, lace from a bra to make curtains, zippers, buttons, lanyards, Velcro, ribbon, rick-rack, beads, vinyl, orphan quilt and embroidery blocks anything I felt would be appropriate.
- Fabrics used were all from my stash – mostly quilting cotton and sensory fabrics – satin, lace, fleece. The backings on both are leftover flannel from a quilt made in 2009.



Both quilts have a little dog, which I made, to put in the pockets. The dogs are made of soft fleece with satin ears and stuffed with poly fiberfill so they are soft and squishy. They are attached to the quilt with the lanyard and a swivel clasp.


