General information about making bags; most patterns call for ½ m of fabric; the expensive parts are stabilizers such as the fusible fleece, Pellon Peltex, Fusible woven interfacing Pellon 101, Pellon Flex Form similar to Soft and Stable, and the hardware

Fabric used to make bags

- Quilting cotton
- Canvas
- Wax canvas
- Craft Tex
- Vinyl with foam backing sometimes called marine vinyl
- Cork- that has been laminated; it's expensive but it does sew nicely

Hardware

- Canadian company in Alberta- Emmaline Bags
- BringBerry in Halifax
